## Days and Months in Hangul

월요일	Monday
화요일	Tuesday
수요일	Wednesday
목요일	Thursday
금요일	Friday
토요일	Saturday
일요일	Sunday

In Hangul, months are based on Sino-Korean numbers. Starting with January, each month is given the number that corresponds to it and is followed by 월 which means “month.” So January is basically the number 1 in Sino-Korean followed by the word “month” like this 일월.

You will also frequently see it represented by a number followed by 월 so 10 월 would be the month of October.

일월	January

삼월	March
사월	April
오월	May
육월	June (when you read it is 유월)
칠월	July
팔월	August
구월	September
십월	October (when you read it it is 시월)
십일월	November
십이월	December

Please note that  
June and October follow  
a slightly different spelling!
