Week 6 -Sentences to practice

Please note that:
SP- Subject Particle
OP-Object Particle
TP- Topic Particle
CP- Contrast Particle

나는 한국어를 배우고 있습니다.
I (TP) Korean language + OP learn “to be” form + politeness

Literal: I Korean language learn(ing) or (learn – to be doing).
Means: I am learning Korean- meaning

나는 미국 사람입니다.
I (TP) American Person + Sp+ infinitive

Literal: I American Person
Meaning: I am American.
Can also use 저는 for “I” -it is more honorific.

영어 할 줄 아세요?
English lang. speak “do you know” polite way to inquire.

Literal: English Language speak do you know?
Meaning: Do you speak English?

화장실이 어디 있나요?
Bathroom+ SP where “do you know” polite way to inquire.

Literal: Bathroom where “do you know”?
Meaning: Where is the bathroom?
