이름이 어떻게 되세요?

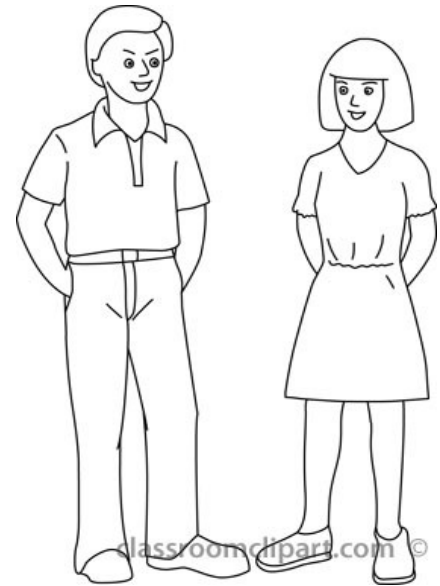
B. 제 이름은 _____ 입니다.

Vocabulary

Please note that the following are what the phrases mean, not always what they are literally. For instance 만나서 반갑습니다 *means* “It's nice to meet/see you” but literally it is “I meet you/ I see you.”

Also remember that in defining singular terms you may not see particles or conjugate endings. In these cases just look for the root word. If you have questions please ask your instructor or consult a good Korean to English dictionary.

1. 안녕하세요. - Hello
2. 만나서 반갑습니다. - It's nice to meet/see you.
3. 이름이 어떻게 되세요? - What is your name
4. 이름 - Name (polite/not formal)
5. 어떻게 되세요? - Idiomatic phrase “like what/how” used simply to inquire politely about a variety of things.
6. 어디에서 왔어요? - “Where are you from?”
7. 어디 - Where
8. 제 이름은 _____ 입니다. - My name is (insert your name).
9. 미국에서 왔어요 - I am from America. (미국 you may put different answer)
10. 안녕히 가세요. - If you are staying you say this to whomever's leaving
11. 안녕히 계세요 - If you are leaving, you say this to whomever is staying.
